g. **Clean campus:** The leaf litter fallen in the campus is used for vermicomposting. Waste water and sewage are treated in inbuilt Sewage treatment plant. The treated water is used for campus plantation. The waste is reduced, water and sewage is recycled and reused in the ecosystem.

h. **Blood group checking and Haemoglobin testing:** It helps in identification of anaemic patients and supplementing them with Iron, Folic acid and vitamin B12.

The Best Practices of the college in the academic year:

a) **Green and Clean campus:** The leaf litter is collected from the campus and used for vermicomposting. The waste water and sewage are treated in inbuilt sewage treatment plant. The treated water is used to maintain the greenery of campus. Thus the waste is reduced, water and sewage is recycled and reused in the campus ecosystem.

b) **Blood group checking and Hemoglobin testing:** As the anaemic patient percentage is high, we have decided to identify anaemic patients from our college students and provide them with Iron, Folic acid and vitamin B12 medicines with the advice of doctor.

c) **Contribution to environmental awareness / protection.**

- College organized Green and Clean Campus drive.

- Solid waste Management through vermicomposting and biogas generation.
- Wild life week was celebrated by displaying posters of plants, animals, microbes and environmental issues to create environmental awareness among the students.
- Exhibition of medicinal plants to create awareness about importance of biodiversity and its conservation.
- NSS volunteers planted saplings, removed plastic and other garbage from the adopted village (Sawantwadi) during NSS camp.
- Recycling of waste water and its reuse in 10 hectares of *NakshatraUdyan* and campus.
- Awareness campaign is organized to create awareness for use of eco-friendly *Ganeshamurti* during *Ganesh* festival.
- No vehicle day is observed by staff and students.

BIOTECHNOLOGY REPORT OF SAPLING PLANTATION AT PAARWADI

In a first attempt of its kind to create awareness about preserving environment, the Maharashtra government will plant **two crore saplings on July 1, 2016**. The State government announced that anyone could join the drive at any place of their choice. Forest Minister Sudhir Mungantiwar announced -

"We are going to plant two crore saplings of 450 species across the state. There is invitation to this plantation drive to one and all. "We already have created 1.75 crore pits ready for the plantation. We have decided to allow public participation in this drive for two reasons. First, we have an inadequate staff of 27,000 employees. Second, I want people to join us in preserving the environment"

The forest department has set a target of saplings plantation for each of its 36 districts. Other government departments have also been asked to join the drive. The Art of Living Foundation and Patanjali Yoga Peeth will also join the drive along with the Railways and Rotary Club Baramati.

The department has planned to set up a permanent committee to take care of the planted saplings. The committee will be responsible if the sapling is damaged.

To follow suit, Department of biotechnology also participated in the plantation drive at paarwadi. 61 students from F.Y.B.Sc Biotechnology, S.Y.B.Sc Biotechnology, T.Y.B.Sc Biotechnology along with 4 Teachers planted around 3500 saplings from 7.45 am to 12.30 noon.
